TURNING REGULATIONS

74.01.311 Authority to Mark
74.02.236 "U" Turns

74.03.000 Left Turn for Parking
74.04.256 Right Turn on Red Signal Prohibited

74.01.311 AUTHORITY TO MARK. The Council may cause markers buttons or signs to be placed within or adjacent to intersections and thereby require and direct, as traffic conditions require, that a different course from that specified by the State law be traveled by vehicles turning at intersections, and when markers, buttons or signs are so placed, no driver of a vehicle shall turn a vehicle at an intersection other than as directed and required by such markers, buttons or signs.

74.02.236 "U" TURNS. It is unlawful for a driver to make a "U" turn except at an intersection, however, "U" turns are prohibited within the business district, at the following designated intersections and at intersections where there are automatic traffic signals.

74.03.000 LEFT TURN FOR PARKING. No person shall make a left hand turn, crossing the centerline of the street, for the purpose of parking on said street.

74.04.256 RIGHT TURN ON RED SIGNAL PROHIBITED. Vehicular traffic facing a steady red signal shall not proceed or make a right turn at the following locations when appropriate signs are in place.
