86.01 LICENSING. Each person living within the City who owns a bicycle may cause the ownership thereof to be registered with the Clerk. Upon registration, the Clerk shall issue a license tag which may be kept permanently attached to the bicycle.

86.02 LICENSE TRANSFER. In the event a licensed bicycle is sold or transferred, the license tag shall pass to the new owner or transferee. The sale or transfer of the bicycle may be reported to the Clerk by the former owner within five (5) days after the sale or transfer of the bicycle. The Clerk shall keep a record of the transfer.

86.03 LOST LICENSE. In the event a license tag is lost, destroyed or stolen, the Clerk may then issue a new license tag.

86.04 REMOVAL OR ALTERATION. No person shall remove or alter a license tag from a bicycle during the period for which issued unless said bicycle is dismantled and no longer operated upon any street in the City.

86.05 MAINTENANCE OF LICENSE RECORDS. The Clerk shall keep a record of the number of each license tag, the date issued, the name and address of the person to whom issued, and the number on the frame of the bicycle for which issued.
